

## EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY

### PREREQUISITES:

- Must be 18 years or older
- Must have a High School diploma or GED Certificate

### REQUIRED TEXT AND MATERIALS

1. EMT - Complete Textbook: A Basic Worktext) Author Limmer & LeBaudour.

2. Physical: The student must be able to perform in accordance with the DSHS Essential of Eligibility (Attached)
3. Immunizations must be completed prior to the first day of clinicals. Proof of said immunization must be presented on official immunization records.
  - a. Hepatitis A- series must be complete prior to the first day of clinicals.
  - b. Hepatitis B - series must be complete prior to the first day of clinicals.
  - c. Negative TB test, not greater than 12 months old
  - d. Tetanus
4. Insurances must be purchased through the TSTC business office on or prior to the first day of class.
  - a. Malpractice/Liability (LBEMT)
  - b. Needlestick Insurance
  - c. General Liability
5. CPR Certification
6. Background Check purchased through TSTC prior to first day of class.
7. Equipment needed.
  - Stethoscope
  - Pen Light
  - Safety Glasses
  - Shears
  - CPR Pocket Mask
  - Watch with capability of counting seconds
8. Uniform: Class Alpha or collard polo style shirt with departmental logo with service blue trousers. **NO FATIGUES.** Belt, plain black, smooth finish. Boots, black, military/service style, leather or nylon combination. If unsure as to the correct attire obtain Coordinators approval.
  - **A medical dictionary is recommended**
  - **All equipment/materials are to be available at all times.**
